



## Specifications for Umra Visa

To apply for an **Umra visa** at the Embassy of Saudi Arabia, we need the following documents:

- A machine-readable passport in the original.** The passport must contain at least two free opposing sides and be valid for 12 months from the start of the trip. In addition, the stamp must not be stamped by the Israeli authorities.
- Two passport photos.** Passports may not be older than six months and must have a white background. Each photo must be backed with the name of the traveller.
- A vaccination passport in the original** with the vaccination:
  - against meningitis (vaccine: ACWY 135). The vaccination should not be less than 10 days and not older than 3 years.
  - against tetanus. The vaccination must not be older than 10 years.
- A medical certificate of vaccination** provided with the vaccination date and vaccine and stamped and signed by the doctor. The vaccination alone is not sufficient.
- Another medical certificate** that the traveller is healthy and free from infectious diseases, has been stamped and signed by the doctor.
- A copy of the marriage certificate for married couples**, from whose names the passport does not indicate that they are married. This is the case if they have different names and the woman keeps her birth name.
- An Islamic certificate for converts** Or travellers from whose name or origin the affiliation to Islam does not occur.
- German residence permits in the original.** This only applies to foreign travellers. The residence permit must be valid for at least 12 months from the start of the trip.
- Under the Saudi constitution, women under the age of 45 may only enter Saudi Arabia accompanied by a close male relative (Mahram such as father, brother or husband). We have no influence on this provision.**
- Visa application form.** A fully completed and signed visa application, link:
- Visa agreement.** A fully completed and signed visa contract, link:
